Pat Hill Photo Collection

Longtime Trinity Church member Pat Hill was the unofficial Cathedral photographer from the 1980s until approximately 2010. In addition to photographing the Cathedral buildings, seasonal services, and special events, she took individual pictures of participants in the Newcomers classes and members of the Vestry.

With the assistance of Archivist Linda L. West, Pat began in 2006 the tedious task of organizing her large collection by topic and date and adding the names of individuals when possible. Linda resumed work on the collection in 2016 with the result that about 85% of the collection is partially processed.

The processed photographs are stored in approximately 150 archival envelopes that are labeled with content information – topics, names, dates as appropriate or possible to determine.

Envelopes are organized within these general categories:

1. Buildings
2. Clergy/Staff/Volunteers
3. Bishops
4. By Church Season
5. By Date, 1960s-2011
6. Special Activities
7. Unprocessed

An additional 200 photos, mostly of groups of people attending meetings, were not possible to identify but have been retained in the rear of the box.

Because not all photos would fit in the box, the Newcomer/Vestry portrait shots are stored in Video Box J. A small percentage of these photos are identified on the backs with names.
